- Jn 1:9 X The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world.
- Jn 1:10 X He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him.
- Jn 1:29 X The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"
- Jn 3:16 X "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.
- Jn 3:17 X For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.
- Jn 3:19 X And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.
- Jn 4:42 X They said to the woman, "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world."
- Jn 6:14 X When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, "This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!"
- Jn 6:33 X For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."
- Jn 6:51 X I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."
- Jn 7:4 X For no one works in secret if he seeks to be known openly. If you do these things, show yourself to the world."
- Jn 7:7 X The world cannot hate you, but it hates me because I testify about it that its works are evil.
- Jn 8:12 X Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
- Jn 8:23 X He said to them, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world.
- Jn 8:26 X I have much to say about you and much to judge, but he who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from him."
- Jn 9:5 X As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world."
- Jn 9:39 X Jesus said, "For judgment I came into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind."

- Jn 10:36 X do you say of him whom the Father consecrated and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?
- Jn 11:9 X Jesus answered, "Are there not twelve hours in the day? If anyone walks in the day, he does not stumble, because he sees the light of this world.
- Jn 11:27 X She said to him, "Yes, Lord; I believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, who is coming into the world."
- Jn 12:19 X So the Pharisees said to one another, "You see that you are gaining nothing. Look, the world has gone after him."
- Jn 12:25 X Whoever loves his life loses it, and whoever hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.
- Jn 12:31 X Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out.
- Jn 12:46 X I have come into the world as light, so that whoever believes in me may not remain in darkness.
- Jn 12:47 X If anyone hears my words and does not keep them, I do not judge him; for I did not come to judge the world but to save the world.
- Jn 13:1 X Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father, having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end.
- Jn 14:17 X even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.
- Jn 14:19 X Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.
- Jn 14:22 X Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?"
- Jn 14:27 X Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.
- Jn 14:30 X I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me,
- Jn 14:31 X but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.
- Jn 15:18 X "If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you.
- Jn 15:19 X If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.
- Jn 16:8 X And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment:

- Jn 16:11 X concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.
- Jn 16:20 X Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy.
- Jn 16:21 X When a woman is giving birth, she has sorrow because her hour has come, but when she has delivered the baby, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world.
- Jn 16:28 X I came from the Father and have come into the world, and now I am leaving the world and going to the Father.”
- Jn 16:33 X I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.”
- Jn 17:5 X And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.
- Jn 17:6 X “I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word.
- Jn 17:9 X I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours.
- Jn 17:11 X And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me, that they may be one, even as we are one.
- Jn 17:13 X But now I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves.
- Jn 17:14 X I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- Jn 17:15 X I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one.
- Jn 17:16 X They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- Jn 17:18 X As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world.
- Jn 17:21 X that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me.
- Jn 17:23 X I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.
- Jn 17:24 X Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because you loved me before the foundation of the world.

- Jn 17:25 X O righteous Father, even though the world does not know you, I know you, and these know that you have sent me.
- Jn 18:20 X Jesus answered him, “I have spoken openly to the world. I have always taught in synagogues and in the temple, where all Jews come together. I have said nothing in secret.
- Jn 18:36 X Jesus answered, “My kingdom is not of this world. If my kingdom were of this world, my servants would have been fighting, that I might not be delivered over to the Jews. But my kingdom is not from the world.”
- Jn 18:37 X Then Pilate said to him, “So you are a king?” Jesus answered, “You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world—to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice.”
- Jn 21:25 X Now there are also many other things that Jesus did. Were every one of them to be written, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.
