Christopher Ash Job is a fireball book. It is a staggeringly honest book. It is a book that knows what people actually say and think—not just what they say publicly in church. If we listen to it carefully, it will touch us, trouble us, and unsettle us at a deep level.

#### No Covenant

**James Bejon** That Job is set in patriarchal times is an important detail, since it explains Job and his friends' method of inquiry. As Job and his friends sit on the plain of Uz and seek to process what has happened, they do not have a clear revelation from God to work with, nor do they have a specific covenant/promise in which they can ground their debate.

- 1. Complete, whole integrity
- 2. He does not deserve the suffering he's about to endure

### Job's Concern | Job 1:4-5

- 1. Good heart for his kids
- 2. Anxious because of no covenant

**Walter Elwell** Arrangement between two parties involving mutual obligations...In the OT the word "covenant" was used in an ordinary human sense as well as in a theological sense. An understanding of human covenants provides a starting point for understanding the covenant between God and human beings.
